Positive Behaviour Policy

Club Rules

Club rules are to be decided as a group and children will create these at the beginning of each academic term or new club. The rules must be displayed for everyone to see during the sessions.

Rewards

ClubsComplete™ staff will always encourage positive behaviour by using stickers, certificates, praise, prizes, charts and awards. Staff have some flexibility with rewards and use a system that best works for that venue based around children's interests and needs.

Red & Amber System

All children will be given a verbal warning first and if they continue to show challenging behaviour then an amber warning will be issued, and parents must be made aware of this. If the behaviour continues a red warning will be issued. All records of amber and red warnings must be written down in the behaviour book and a behaviour slip must be filled in and sent out to parents.

If a child appears within the behaviour book on two occasions as a result of receiving a red warning within a week then the child will not be able to attend the next session of ClubsComplete™. This is to ensure all children have the opportunity to enjoy clubs and feel safe and comfortable within the sessions. If poor behaviour continues ClubsComplete™ will have a meeting with parents to discuss using provisions going forward.
